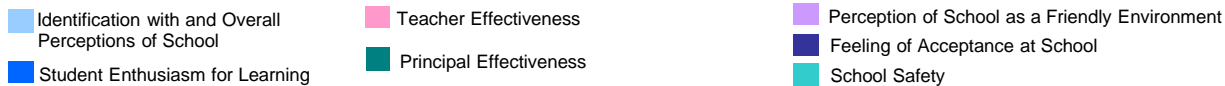
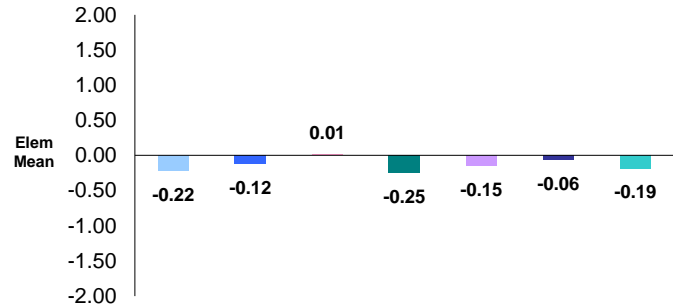
Standardized Climate Scores compared to the District

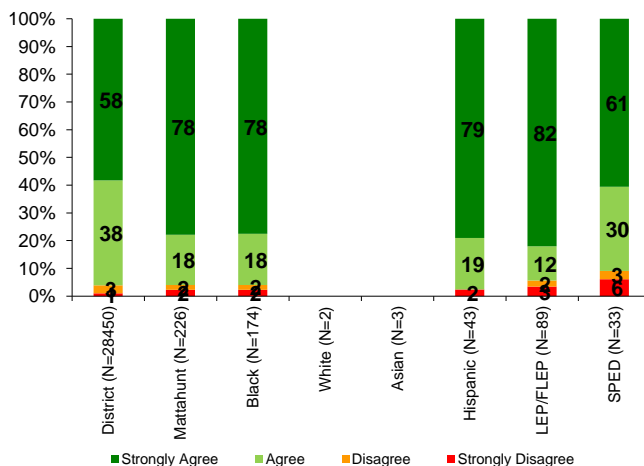
Standardized Climate Scores compared to Elementary Schools

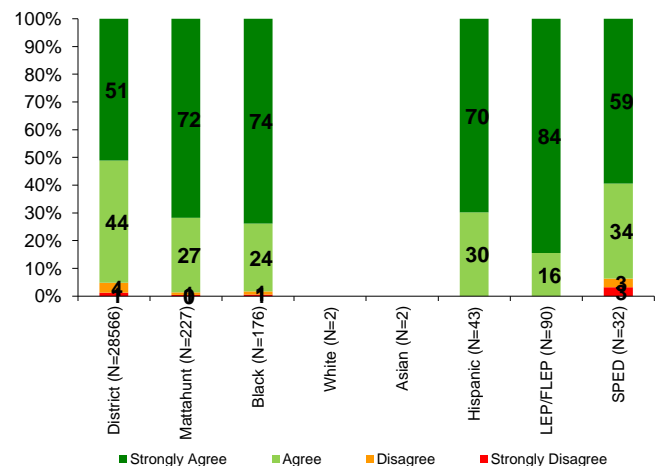
**My teacher expects me to make good grades:

Percentage of student responses**

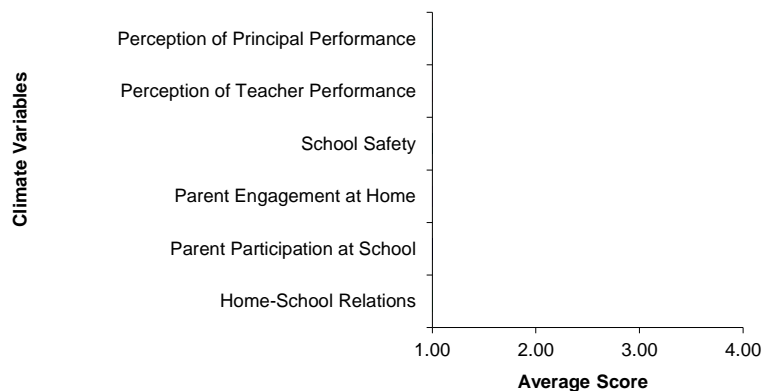

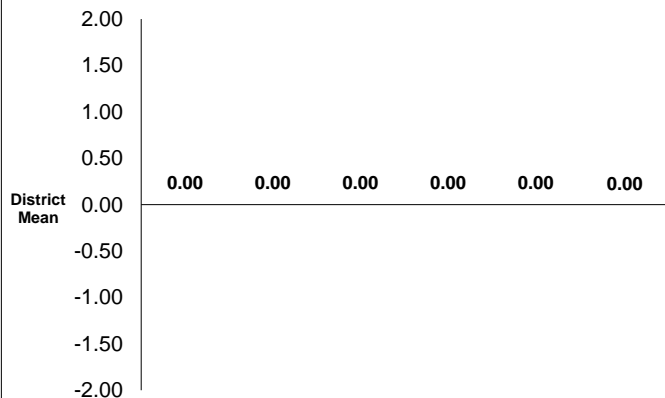

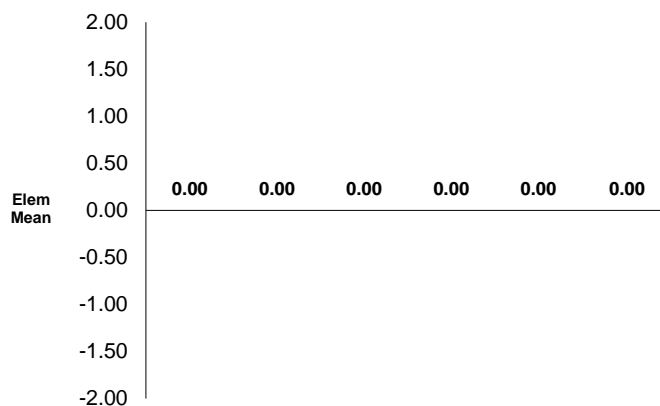
Standardized Climate Scores Compared to the District

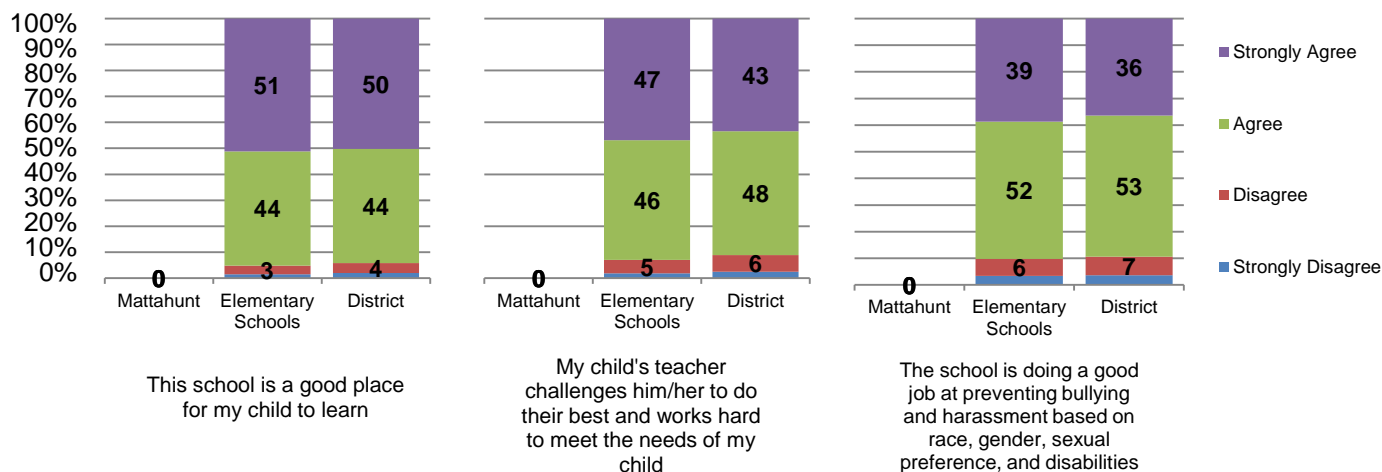
Standardized Climate Scores Compared to Elementary Schools

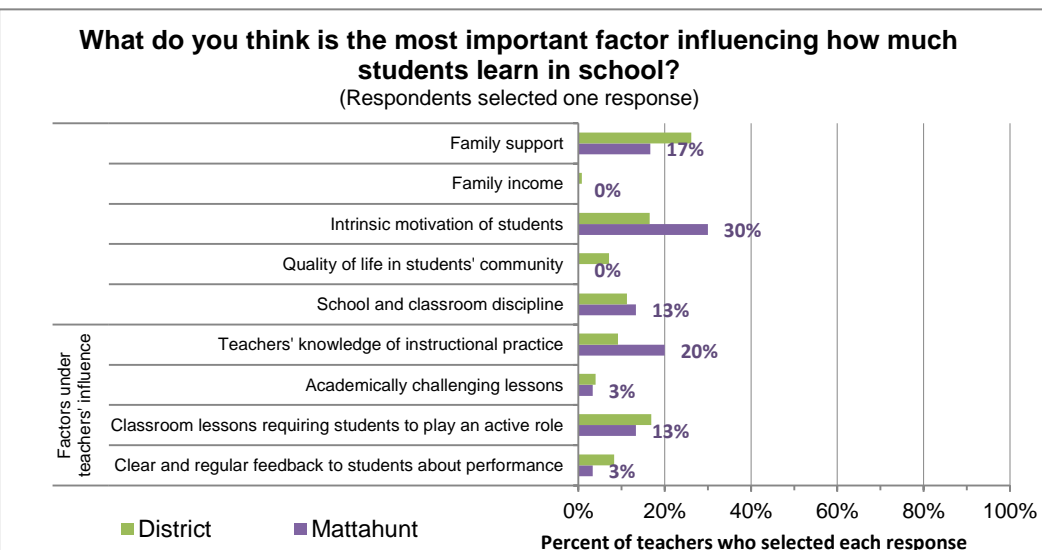
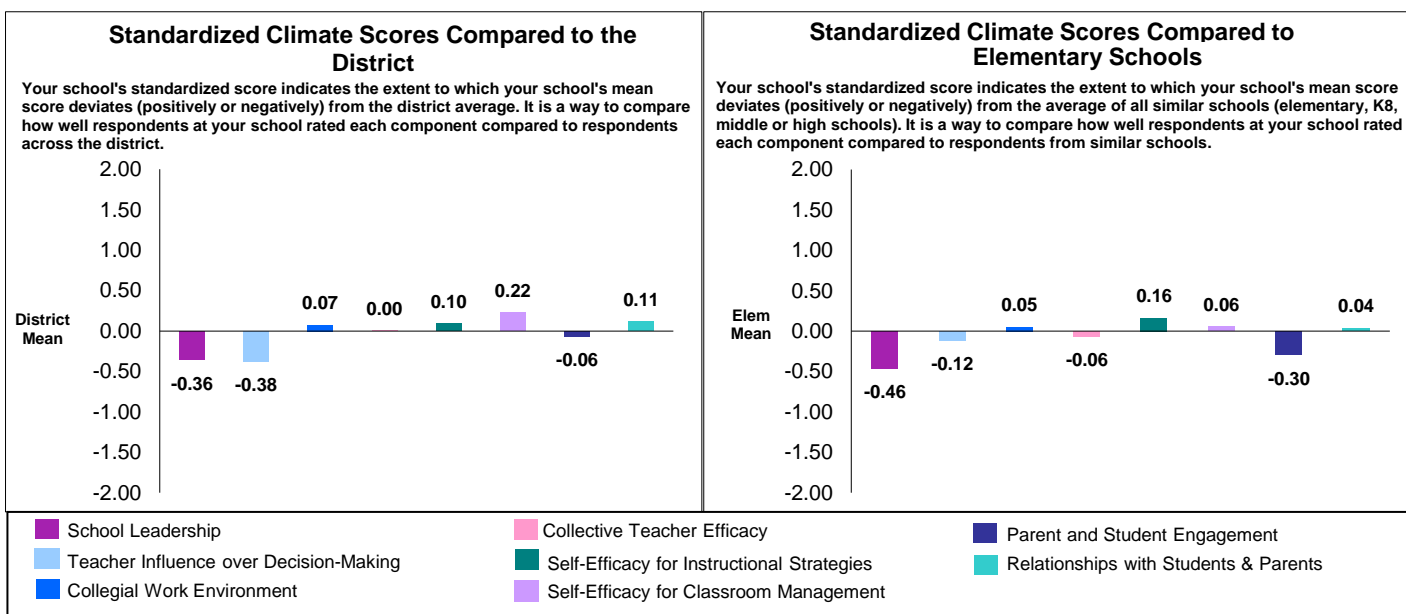
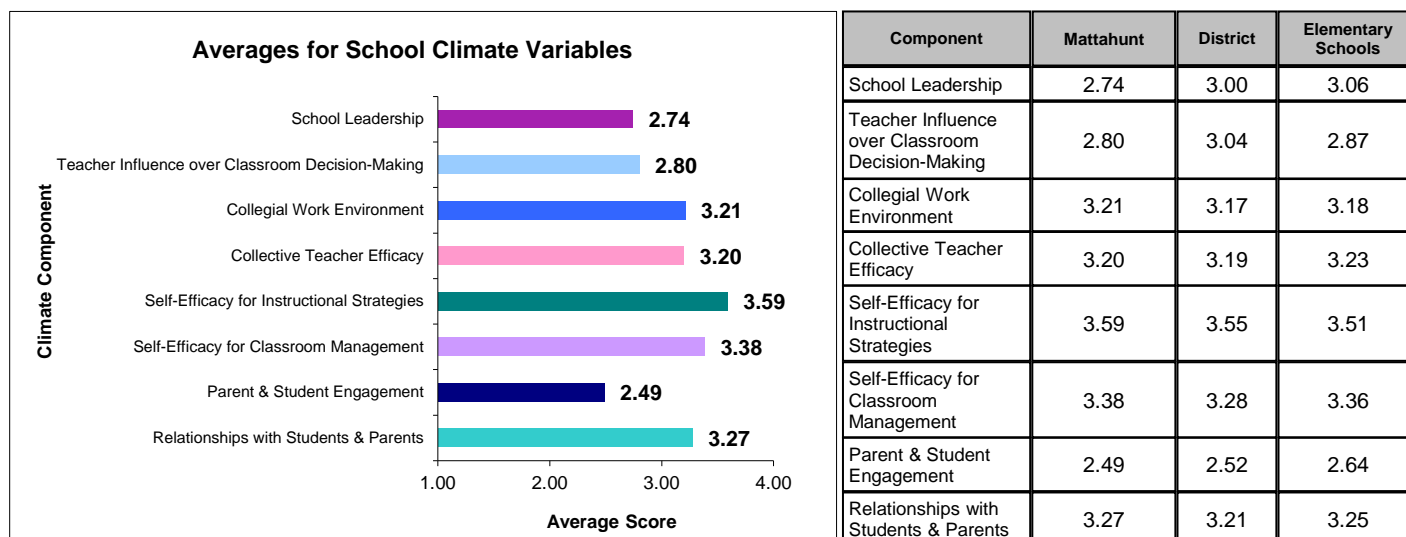

Response rate: 31/57 = 54%



Trends in the way teachers across the district responded:

* 26% of teachers selected family support as the most important factor.

* Approximately 17% of teachers selected intrinsic motivation of students as the most important factor.

* 38% of teachers selected one of 4 responses that are under teachers' influence.

* These trends mirror the trends from 2010-2011.
